History Trail

Take a step back in time on our History Trail. Admire the towering walls of Dean Castle and explore stories of the Park from the last 1000 years. Visit the Scott-Ellis graveyard, surrounded by our wonderful collection of pine trees.

Countryside Trail

Experience the changing seasons on our Countryside Trail. Can you spot the different wildlife by the rivers, ponds, fields and woodlands of the Park? Look in the hedgerows for bees and beetles and in the trees for birds and bats.

Come and find out who is on the farm today. We usually have pigs, goats, sheep and deer as well as geese, turkeys and ducks.

History Trail

Distance 1km (0.6 miles)
There is a steep climb at the start as you leave the visitor centre, but the paths are wide and have no steps. However, by adding in an extra 400m (0.2 miles) you can climb a short flight of steps to the top of the motte and bailey.

Countryside Trail

Distance 3.2km (2.0 miles)
This trail goes through most of our woodland and along the rivers. It has a few strenuous climbs and some steps.

Farm Trail

Distance 2.1km (1.3 miles)
The farm trail takes you to the Rural Life Centre and the farm. It has a few steep climbs.
