SUPERteams TEAM MANAGER'S INFORMATION

Thank you for your entry into the FPSG **scottishathletics** U12 SUPERteams on Saturday 15th June. All information for this event can be downloaded from the scottishathletics Fixture page [HERE](#).

Arrival

Car Parking is available on a first come first served basis and is available within the stadium grounds. All drivers must be considerate and park responsibly.

Please access the arena via Turnstiles 7,8 & 9 onto the main concourse. Athletes, spectators and coaches will NOT be permitted to enter via the main reception area.

Admission - **Cost £3**, Under 16's are FREE. Coaches FREE on production of valid coaching licence. Coaches are advised to make sure their UKA licence is up to date. If in doubt please contact the **scottishathletics** office ahead of the event.

Programmes will not be on sale at this event. All relevant information will be posted on walls within the facility and will be available via the **scottishathletics** website.

Declarations: 0900hrs to 1030hrs

Declarations

Declarations will be on the concourse immediately after admissions. Team Managers **ONLY** should report to collect team packs. Athletes should proceed outside and meet their teams in the stand.

Under 12 SUPERteams should be declared by 0930hrs for those competing at 1000hrs and 1030hrs for those competing at 1100hrs.

A declaration sheet will be attached to your event pack. This should be completed with details of athletes competing and handed in at declarations on the morning of competition **by the Team Manager or another club representative**. All athletes must be paid up members of **scottishathletics** and born between 01.09.07 and 15.06.10 to be eligible to compete in U12 SUPERteams. Teams should not be declared until all athletes are present.

PLEASE DO NOT CHANGE TEAMS AFTER SUBMITTING THEM TO DECLARATIONS.

TEAM MANAGERS MUST ENSURE THAT ATHLETES ARE WEARING THE CORRECT NUMBER AS THAT PROVIDED ON THE DECLARATIONS SHEET.

It may be possible to form composite teams on the day of competitions. A board will be available at declarations for teams to list athletes available for a composite team.

Event Assembly

Athletes should report to the assembly areas prepared to compete, with numbers securely fastened to their club vest (Front and Back) and visible to officials. Spikes should be checked and tightened before reporting, and no additional kit or bottles should be brought into the assembly areas.

Field Events:

Athletes should report to the Field Assembly Area in the middle of the stand on the back straight at least 15 minutes before the timetabled start time for their event. Pool numbers will be displayed here. Athletes should sit at the relevant pool number and will be collected and escorted to their event site.

Track Events:

Assembly Area will be within the stand nearest the 100m Start and clearly signposted on the day. Athletes should report at least 15 minutes before the timetabled start time for their event to be collected by officials and escorted to the start line. Teams may not use their own batons during relays, and must not bring a baton to the assembly area.

General Information

- All athletes in the U12 SUPERteams must compete in their Club Colours.
- Athletes changing, Assembly Areas and Pools will be clearly signposted on the day.
- Personal equipment, including phones and music players **MUST NOT** be brought into the competition area. All balls, including footballs, rugby balls or howlers/NERF Balls, are not permitted within the arena.
- **Care should be taken when conducting warm ups prior to events. Teams should not expect to have access to Scotstoun's indoor area for warming up at this event.**
- Spike Length: spike length must not exceed 6mm
- Your attention is drawn to UK Athletics Rule 145S1 regarding Misconduct. Athletes should make themselves aware of the content of this Rule.
